## **Transport:**

Bus - Route **#13** goes all the way into Newcastle and also goes to Glendale Stockland as mentioned above and goes every 30mins. Route **263 & 262** go to Charlestown every 30mins. Route **#44** goes to Kotara Westfield but does take a long time and is hourly.

Trains - Cardiff has it's own station at the top of the hill at Cardiff. It is about a 15-20min walk to the club but there is also a taxi rank at the station. The train will get you into Newcastle Exchange and there you can find more bus routes or jump onto the Light Rail and go all the way up to Newcastle Beach or stop in between at Civic and a short walk to NEX Club (Newcastle City Wests Club) where the main social hub will be for the games
